L.V.S. Reigns Supreme at Checkmate 2026

Three Gold Medals & Two Silver at DPS East Patna's Inter-School Chess Championship

The corridors of DPS East Patna echoed with the quiet intensity of focused minds on 8th and 9th May 2026, as schools from across the region gathered for Checkmate — one of the most anticipated inter-school chess championships of the year. Amid the concentration and competition, one school rose above the rest: Litera Valley School (L.V.S.).
